**Shillong, April 13, 2004:** With a view to maintain peace and tranquility during the ensuing 14 Lok Sabha Election, Section 144 Cr. PC has been promulgated in East Garo Hills District and Ri Bhoi District, prohibiting any person or group of persons from causing obstruction to the movement of people and vehicular traffic, carrying of arms of any description and other lethal weapons by members of the public throughout the two Districts with the exemption of security and paramilitary personnel on duty.

### **ALTERNATIVE DOCUMENTS FOR IDENTIFICATION**

Shillong, April 13, 2004: In view of the ensuing Lok Sabha Election scheduled for April 20, 2004, the Election Commission of India has notified that voters who do not possess Electors Photo Identity Card, can produce as forms of identification Passports; Driving Licenses; Income Tax Identity (PAN) Card; Service Identity Cards issued to its employees by State/Central Government, Public Sector undertakings, Local bodies or other Private Industrial Houses; Bank/Kisan/Post Office Passbooks (accounts open on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2004); Property documents such as Pattas, registered Deeds etc; Ration Cards issued on or before 31st March 2004; SC/ST/OBC Certificates issued by competent authority on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March; Pension documents such as ex-serviceman's Pension Book/ Pension Payment Order, ex-servicemen's Widow/Dependent Certificates. Old Age Pension Order, Widow Pension Order' Railway Identification cards; Freedom Fighter Identify Cards, Arms License and certificate of physical Handicap by competent Authority issued on or before March 31, 2004.

Any other persons who fail to produce the EPIC or any of the above mentioned documents will not be entitled to cast their vote in the ensuing Parliamentary Elections.
