## SECTION 144 Cr. PC PROMULGATED

**Shillong, February 6, 2004:** To ensure smooth and peaceful election to the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council, which will be held on February 12, 2004, and counting of votes to be held on February 14, 2004, the District Magistrate, East Khasi Hills District has promulgated section 144 Cr.PC in the whole of the East Khasi Hills District, prohibiting carrying of arms, ammunitions, knives, doas and other weapons by members of the public or cause any obstruction or annoyance to other members of the public.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and remain in force until further notice.

## **1<sup>ST</sup> MEETING OF REDCO**

**Shillong, February 6, 2004:** With a view to achieve its aims and objectives, the first meeting of the Ri Bhoi Economic Development Committee (REDCO), under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner, Ri Bhoi District, Mr. W L Lyngdoh, was held at the premises of Umdihar Auditorium on February 4, 2004.

In the meeting, the Committee resolved to take up certain programmes pertaining to the upliftment and development of the District in different spheres, such as setting up of Ginger Processing Unit at Umsning, Fruit Processing Unit at Nongpoh, Science and Technology Centre, Technology Demonstration at Nongpoh and to establish a Science Park at Umiam with a Ropeway linking Umbir and Umiam.
